

2024 Columbia Riding Club Year End Awards

This year the Columbia Riding Club will once again be holding year end awards. There are 2 show series for Year End Awards: the Sunday Pleasure Shows and Wednesday Gaming Shows.

The purpose the this award program is to allow participates to earn special awards and prizes from the Columbia Riding Club, to encourage participation in horse shows, to promote Columbia Riding Club and to encourage new members.

In scoring for the Year End Awards, the Columbia Riding Club will honor the horse/rider combination that has accumulated the greatest number of points during the show series. Accumulated points for the following placings: Champion, Reserve Champion and 3rd thru 6th place in a division.

Sunday Pleasure Show Series: 11 Divisions !!!!

Dates: May 5, June 2, July 7, August 4 and September 8

- 1. Must be a CRC member in good standing; nomination is for same rider/horse combination.
- 2. SIGN UP! Members interested in being considered for the Year-End Awards must sign up at the secretary stand **prior** to the start of the class. Points will not be counted until we receive your sign-up sheet. There is a **\$15 nomination fee per division** for the Year End Awards. Awards will be given at CRC Banquet.
- 3. There is no sign-up limit to open a division.
- 4. *In the following 5 divisions, the Champion will receive a <u>BUCKLE Award</u>: Miniature Horse, English Youth, English Open, Western Youth, Western Open. There must be at least 5 nominees in the division for the buckle award unless buckle is sponsored. A sponsor can choose any division for a sponsored buckle.*
- 5. Nominated rider/horse combination must participate in at least 3 of the 5 Sunday Pleasure Shows and must participate in at least 2 qualifying classes of the division per show you sign-up in (except LL and WTJ divisions).
- 6. Points will be calculated on a sliding scale using the number of participants up to 7. Participation in class = 1 point.
- 7. A horse substitution because of injury/health with a veterinarian note will be allowed and points will stand. Other horse substitutions will void all points and start new at the show in which a new form is received.
- 8. Year End Award participants will be assigned a back number and that number MUST be used throughout the show season to receive points.
- 9. There will be High Point Winners of the Pleasure Show Series for English and Western. These have no nomination fee. You are automatically eligible for these when you sign up for Year End Awards.

Classes: Halter English-type will be counted towards all English divisions. Halter Stock-type will be counted towards all Western divisions. All Age In-Hand Trail and Trail W/J & W/J/L will be counted towards English & Western Open, Novice, Youth & Adult divisions.
